Ineligible Shareholders - Adherium Limited Rights Issue Offer

On 11 December 2019 Adherium Limited (**Company**) announced that it is undertaking a non-renounceable pro-rata entitlement offer of 1 New Share (**New Share**) for every 1 Share held at the Record Date of 7.00pm (AEDT) on 16 December 2019, at an Issue Price of \$0.03 per New Share to raise a minimum of \$2.5 million and a maximum of approximately \$5.4 million (before costs) (**Offer**), on the basis that no more than approximately 180 million New Shares will be issued pursuant to the Offer.

The Offer is being made without a prospectus or other disclosure document in accordance with section 708AA of the Corporations Act. A copy of the above announcements, with further details of the Offer, is available on the Company's website (www.adherium.com) and also on the ASX Announcement Platform. A copy of the Rights Issue Offer Document has been lodged with the ASX and is available for viewing on the ASX website and the Company's website (at www.adherium.com).

As permitted by law, the Company has decided that it is unreasonable to make the Offer to any Shareholder with a registered address outside Australia or New Zealand as at the Record Date (namely 16 December 2019), having regard to:

- (a) the number of Shareholders with addresses in such other countries as a proportion of total Shareholders in the Company;
- (b) the number and value of the Shares those Shareholders would be offered under the Offer; and
- (c) the cost to the Company of complying with applicable legal and regulatory requirements in such other countries.

Accordingly, the Offer will not be made to shareholders resident in the jurisdiction in which your shareholding is registered.

This letter is to inform you that under the terms of the Offer, you are an ineligible shareholder and therefore not eligible to subscribe for New Shares under the Offer and no entitlements will be issued to you. This letter is not an offer to issue New Shares or entitlements to you, nor an invitation for you to apply for New Shares.
